This consultancy will build on learning about successes and challenges from Phase 1.

The successful consultant or team leader will demonstrate the following:

- At least 7 years' experience in international aid with a proven background in program design and facilitation
- Demonstrated knowledge of and experience working with communities (especially churches) in the Pacific
- Demonstrated experience in participatory co-design processes
- Experience working with civil society organisations in Australia and the Pacific
- Familiarity with DFAT monitoring and evaluation standards
- Good understanding of issues of concern to people in the Pacific including climate change, locally led and Pacific-led approaches, theological approaches to behaviour change, and gender equality, disability inclusion and social inclusion
- Success working as part of a team
- Strong communication and writing skills

- A proposal including methodology
- Timeframe for undertaking the assignment (must be completed by March 2025)
- A quote / costing for completion of the work
- CVs for any consultants who will be involved in delivering the assignment
